Student Programs

Student Programs offers youth volunteer program consultation, access to recruit youth volunteers directly from the classroom, priority status for school-related volunteer projects and the ability to post youth opportunities at powercrew.org. Agencies can receive funding for a variety of college and high school summer intern programs.

Community Service Restitution

Hundreds of court-mandated individuals are available to help meet your volunteer needs. More than 500 nonprofit agencies benefit from the 400,000 service hours worked annually by these volunteers.

VERIFYI

The VERIFYI program provides the most comprehensive criminal background check available to Texas nonprofit agencies. It includes Texas DPS records, multi-jurisdictional checks and Social Security verification. VERIFYI offers a new online web-based application and a 24-hour turnaround time on all records.

Donated Goods Center

Many agencies stretch their budgets by paying pennies on the dollar when shopping for their clients. Agency staff may also shop at the Volunteer Center's 18,000-sq.-ft. warehouse full of office supplies, clothing, toys, furniture and more.

Hands On North Texas

Hands On provides access to hundreds of individual, family and group volunteers in North Texas. Agencies receive the ability to list volunteer projects and ongoing opportunities at handsonnorthtexas.org. Hands On also offers group project planning assistance and priority status for Hands At Work Corporate Employee Volunteer Projects.
